## PRAYER FOCUS & REQUESTS

### Sunday 2 September

- Personal: Ask God to give us a heart that is able to believe and not doubt that He is able to do more than we can imagine and a heart that allows Him to move in, through and around our lives continually.
- Personal: Ask God to help us to be the peacemaker in our relationships, friendships, and families (Rom. 12:18, 14:19; Eph. 4:29).

### Monday 3 September

- Malaysia: Pray for the Prime Minister and the Cabinet Ministers, that they will discharge their duties with wisdom, integrity and diligence.
- Pray that the authorities will uphold the constitutional freedom of religion, in order to promote mutual respect and tolerance, and to reject all form of religious bigotry.

### Tuesday 4 September

- Pray that those who report, edit and distribute the news will do so without fear or favour.

### Wednesday 5 September

- Malaysia: Ask God to intensify our hunger and sharpen our discernment. Pray for a mighty move of the Spirit, that with one heart, one soul, one mind, we will return to God in repentance for personal, corporate and national sins.
- Church: In repentance, ask God to forgive us for our carelessness and recklessness, for falling for the fanciful, the sensational, the ear-tickling preachings, for misinterpreting the Word and mangling the truth and for exalting the authority of personal experience over the authority of Scripture.

### Thursday 6 September

- Church: Ask God to help us to live a godly life that passes His blessings and a strong Christian heritage to the next generations (Joshua 24:15)

### Friday 7 September

- Church: Pray that our church becomes a centre of sound Word, excellent teaching and expository preaching. Ask God to raise up many more teachers of the Word who are rooted in the Word and skilful in teaching the Word and with a desire to mentor a new generation of theologians, thinkers and teachers.
